

## 1108-1110 Chaucer Street Plant List

### Front of house:

- Coast Live Oak tree, a heritage tree (city protected)
- Toyon (smaller tree/shrub)—gets berries in the winter that birds like robins and waxwings love
- Persimmon (small tree) Understory:
- Hummingbird sage

### Bird garden (behind picket fence, 1108):

- Ceanothus (Ray Hartman variety) (tree)
- Cascara sagrada (small tree)
- Two redbuds
- Ninebark (ground cover)
- Sword ferns
- Hummingbird sage
- Native wild strawberry (ground cover)
- Meadow rue (deciduous)
- Oregon grape
- Ninebark (low growing groundcover)
- Ribes viburnifolium
- Calycanthus (spicebush)

### Side of 1108

- Prunus illicifolia (seen through dining room window)
- Ceanothus (by mailbox)
- Calycanthus (spicebush) and thimbleberry (by front porch)
- Hazelnut (next to fence)

### Side of 1110

- Manzanita, with rosemary and lemon tree, and native monkeyflowers
- Apple tree (products red delicious apples late fall)
- Back yard
- “Woodland glade” behind 1110 bedroom window:
- Ceanothus (tree)
- Red alder (tree)
- Salvia lemmonii
- Matilija poppy
- Hollyleaf redberry (tiny, just getting started)
- Sword ferns
- Ribes viburnifolium (small round leaves; delicate, tiny pink flowers)

### Shrubs:

- Calycanthus (deciduous); leaves smell like wine grapes when crushed
- Dogwood (deciduous)
- Snowberry
- Redbud (deciduous)
- Western bleeding heart (deciduous groundcover, comes up in spring with beautiful pink flowers and carpets the ground)
- Hummingbird sage (deep pink flowers)
- Heuchera
- Bee plant
- Mugwort (delicious smell when you rub the leaves)

### Herb garden:

- Asparagus
- Fennel
- Oregano
- Chives

### Trees, farther in the back:

- California Bay
- Madrone
- Persimmon

### Shrubs and understory:

- Elderberry
- Ribes sanguineum
- Wild grape
- Sword ferns
- Heuchera
- Native grasses
- Campagnula

### Between the two back doors:

- Wild grape
- Pineapple sage (hummingbird favorite)
- Rosemary (honeybees love)
